STATE PROPERTY PROGRAM

- A wide variety of state property is available, including desktop and laptop computers, monitors, desks, chairs, file cabinets, bookcases, shelving units, tables, lights and more!
- State agencies and institutions report their surplus property, and those items are available to other state agencies, political subdivisions, and eligible non-profits. State Surplus Property also sells and auctions property for political subdivisions.
- It's not just agencies that recieve these savings many items are also available to the public!
- The public can purchase State Property through GovDeal Auctions. See Auction Information.

FEDERAL PROPERTY PROGRAM

- Federal property includes construction equipment and machinery, motor vehicles, military property, food service equipment, medical equipment, supplies, clothing, miscellaneous hand tools and more!
- State Surplus Property acquires a variety of federal property from all over the nation and even overseas! State Surplus Property identifies property that would benefit eligible North Dakota organizations. Eligible organizations can also request specific items they need.
- This property is only available to eligible political subdivisions and eligible non-profits.
- The public can purchase Federal Property through GSA Auctions. See Auction Information.

LAW ENFORCEMENT SUPPORT OFFICE PROGRAM

- Available property includes weapons, protective equipment and tactical vehicles.
- Federal law enforcement equipment and supplies are available to qualifying North Dakota entities with law enforcement responsibilities.
